AROC impairment codes – Version 4 dataset (July 2012)

GUIDE FOR USE: The <u>AROC impairment codes coding guidelines</u> has been developed to assist in correctly classifying rehabilitation episodes according to impairment groups. The episode should be classified according to the primary reason for the current episode of rehabilitation care. Note: rehabilitation program names related to funding are not necessarily the same as the impairment group names.
